Notes on Duties for New Members

It is preferred that Members, and in the case of Joint/Family membership their partners, perform duties during the season. New Members are not required to carry out skilled duties since they require suitable training and experience, unless you believe that you have the skills required in which case please make this known to the Management Committee. Rescue Crews should be competent to swim, be in good health and if subject to seasickness should consider taking suitable medication in advance. The Duty Rotas are published in Mainsheet, our monthly Magazine, early in the season. In the event that you are unable to perform a duty a substitute must be found in reasonable time. If you wish to familiarise yourself with these duties it is usually possible to visit the Race Control Box during Racing or to go out in Ark, by contacting the relevant Race Officer, preferably in advance.
